#### What happens when we die?

<sup>1</sup> Now, brothers and sisters, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand. **1 Corinthians 15:1, NIV**

<sup>12</sup> But if it is preached that Christ has been raised from the dead, how can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead? <sup>13</sup> If there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised. <sup>14</sup> And if Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith...<sup>16</sup> For if the dead are not raised, then Christ has not been raised either. <sup>17</sup> And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins. **1 Corinthians 15:12-17, NIV**

<sup>51</sup> Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed—<sup>52</sup> in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed. <sup>53</sup> For the perishable must clothe itself with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality. <sup>54</sup> When the perishable has been clothed with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality, then the saying that is written will come true: "Death has been swallowed up in victory." **1 Corinthians 15:51-54, NIV**

<sup>7</sup> The dust returns to the ground it came from, and the spirit returns to God who gave it. **Ecclesiastes 12:7, NIV**

<sup>27</sup> Just as people are destined to die once, and after that to face judgment. **Hebrews 9:27, NIV**

*<sup>20</sup> But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep. **1 Corinthians 15:20, NIV***


