¹³ From Paphos, Paul and his companions sailed to Perga in Pamphylia, where John left them to return to Jerusalem. ¹⁴ From Perga they went on to Pisidian Antioch. On the Sabbath they entered the synagogue and sat down. **Acts 13:13-14, NIV**

¹⁶ Standing up, Paul motioned with his hand and said: "Fellow Israelites and you Gentiles who worship God, listen to me!" ¹⁷ The **God** of the people of Israel **chose** our ancestors; he made the people prosper during their stay in Egypt; with mighty power **he led** them out of that country; . . . They are now his witnesses to our people. **Acts 13:26-31, NIV**
