


We are asking everyone at CrossWalk to pray, sacrifice and give in new ways during this season.

Our new building will be permeable to the community. We want it to be inviting and usable for those in our community seeking a safe place for counseling, groups, service opportunities, recovery ministry and more.

Picture an inviting patio area and reception area where friends and families can connect on the weekend and during the week. Picture a multi-use worship space that doubles as a reception or conference space. Picture a youth worship space that doubles as an elegant wedding venue. Picture a fun playground and CrossWalk Kids space that will also double as rooms for groups to use throughout the week.

For every age and every stage in life, CrossWalk will be a lighthouse, landmark and launchpad as we bring Jesus to the last, the lost and the least of our community.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the purpose of IMAGINE?

The purpose of IMAGINE is to engage our entire church in giving time, energy, money and resources to accomplish the following strategies over the next few years so that we become...

...A Lighthouse

What is the financial goal of this initiative?

The estimated cost for our facility in Laveen is 6 million dollars. The goal of Imagine is to raise 2 million dollars towards this project. During this time we ask the CrossWalk family to Imagine the possibilities God has in mind for our church. We ask that every member of the family would pray for the initiative and give towards the project, over and above your regular offering. These offerings will be received over a three-year period.

Why are we doing this now?

We have been very comfortable being a mobile church over the last 17 years, but circumstances have changed in recent years.

In some ways we believe God is pushing us. In less than a week in 2020 we were reminded of how quickly we can be homeless as a church. We also know with the changing climate in our country, we could be asked to leave public school settings because of our gospel message.

And we believe *God is pulling us*. Since the building of the 202 loop, the Laveen community has exploded. Thousands of new homes have been built and thousands more are on the way. Building the facility now will allow us to reach these new residents not only on Sunday, but all week long as we grow our ministry to serve our community.

When will this initiative end?

The Imagine Initiative will begin September 12, 2021 and go through October 31, 2024.

Are my gifts to this initiative over and above my normal offerings a part of my normal tithe?

All offerings given to the Imagine Initiative are completely separate from our regular offerings. This means that we are asking that Imagine offerings are given in addition to what you are already giving now.

When will we be asked to make our commitment?

Our Big Give Sunday will be October 24, 2021.

What will take place on Big Give Sunday?

On our Big Give Sunday we will worship, celebrate, and pray over what God has planned for the coming years at CrossWalk. We will ask our entire church, 100%, to participate by committing to give financially to the Imagine Initiative. We ask that everyone submit their Imagine commitment card on this day at the end of each service.

Will financial commitments be made public?

We will make public and celebrate the total commitment given by the church. Personal financial commitments will **NOT** be made public or shared in any way.

Can commitments be changed if necessary?

CREATIVE WAYS TO GIVE

Your margin for giving may feel much smaller than you'd like it to feel. That's not unusual! But often as we expand our vision to include all of the resources that God has given to us, we begin to see new avenues for generosity we hadn't initially considered. You may be amazed at your capacity to give! The following 7 options are suggested as a means to help you consider some creative ways to give.

3. Redirect current expenditures

Families often have short-term expenses factored into their budget. When those expenses end, those funds can be redirected without major budget adjustments. For example, a family that pays off a loan may choose to continue budgeting the same amount of the loanpayment as a gift.

5. Donate Stored Resources

Appreciated assets (like stocks or real estate) can also be resources for generosity. Talk to a financial advisor for ways to maximize these gifts.

7. Commit Unexpected Cash

Sudden influxes of cash due to an inheritance, a second income, or gifts can be added to gifts from regular income.

1. Practice priority budgeting

Many families will choose to rearrange their priorities and give up something in their current budget in order to give more. Priority budgeting may mean postponing a planned expenditure, like

a new car, vacation, home remodel, or other major purchase.

2. Increase giving with increased

We often increase our standard of living when we receive a raise or a bonus. Some families elect to keep their standard of living the same and increase their giving by the amount of the raise or bonus.

4. Sacrifice your extra time

Extra time can be converted into extra income and greater giving capacity through part-time jobs.

6. Give from your excess

Some families save over a period of years for a special project. Funds initially saved for vacations, new vehicles, or other projects can be redirected as gifts.

What Question Am I Asking?

What does God want me to keep from God's resources?

Generous givers live out their belief that God owns everything. They keep only what they need while investing the rest in His Kingdom.

What does God want me to give from God's resources?

Tithers believe God owns everything. They live off 90% and invest 10% in His Kingdom.

What does God say to do with God's money?

Consistent givers have an understanding that God owns everything. They give consistently, but they haven't yet reached 10%.


What do I do with God's money?

Occasional givers are beginning to understand the concept of biblical stewardship. They haven't yet developed a regular pattern of giving and don't yet give a certain percentage, but they give.

What do I do with my money?

First time givers are moving in practice from owners to stewards. They have taken the first step of faith and invested something financially in God's Church and His Kingdom.
