

My Next Step:

Read Romans 12:4-8

We use the word “member” to describe someone associated with a church, not to bring images of a country club, but imagery of a body with many parts/members. How does this picture of a body show the importance and need for everyone to be involved in service?

Have each member of the group share where they serve and what they like about it. If someone is not currently serving at CrossWalk don't make them feel inferior in any way, but invite them to shadow with you for a day where you serve or direct them to the HUB to find a place where they would like to serve.

Doing Life Together:

Each person take a moment to consider **one thing to praise God** for in the past week, also one issue **to pray to God** for in the past week for yourself or a friend. Share your response and brief summary with the group.

Prayer:

In the prayer section we encourage you to take about 10 minutes to pray as a group. Include the issues of prayer and praise from above. Set aside about 10 minutes so it doesn't feel rushed. Go around in a circle with each person praying, a person may say, “pass” if they are uncomfortable praying out loud.

Friendship:

Spend the final 10 to 15 minutes of group catching up with other group members. Take time to get to know those you don't know quite as well. Make sure to include everyone in the group.
